

DINOX CREAM



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

DINOX CREAM is topical cream that forms a protective barrier over the skin, prevents radiation damages and promotes healing.

Under the supervision of a healthcare professional, **DINOX CREAM** is used to manage itch and burns associated with radiation dermatitis. It also helps relieve dry waxy skin by maintaining a moist wound and skin environment, which is beneficial to the healing process.

CLINICAL STUDIES

I. Open clinical study 34 patients undergoing radiotherapy were treated with Dinox cream topical application during radiotherapy cycles, twice a day as soon as signs of erythema of first degree were evident. Conclusions: excellent safety and tolerability profile, protects skin from exposure to radiation, helps to restore normal physiological skin state.

II. Evaluation of the soothing and re-epithelializing activity of topical products. Conclusions: **DINOX CREAM** showed a significant soothing activity and re-epithelizing activity on the skin sides submitted to stripping injury.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

HYALURONAN BUTYRATE_FORMATE (SHBF) is a sodium hyaluronate derivative in which hydroxylic functions of the polysaccharide are coupled by butyric acid [regulates the inflammation process]. This modification reduces the rate of enzymatic degradation.
