

OSTEOPOROSIS PATCH



□ PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Patch containing vitamins that contribute to normal function of bones, teeth and muscles.

□ MECHANISM OF ACTION

The most convenient and innovative way of taking vitamins is using patches. The advantages of taking vitamins through the skin include avoiding first hepatic pass, which can lower the bioavailability; ease of use for people with trouble swallowing; availability in blood is almost immediate and gradually released during the 24 hours of application.

□ THE ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

Two different compositions are available:

A- Cosmetic product:

Pantothenic acid (Vitamin B5)
Vitamin C

PANTOTHENIC ACID: also known as Vitamin B5, contributes to the normal synthesis and metabolism of vitamin D, very important vitamin for bones, teeth and muscles.

VITAMIN C: contributes to the normal formation of collagen, necessary for the normal bone and cartilage functions.

B- Other categories:

Vitamin D3
Vitamin K2
Vitamin C

VITAMIN D3: contributes to the normal development and function of bones, teeth and muscles.

VITAMIN K2: helps Vitamin D do its action better than alone.

VITAMIN C: contributes to the normal formation of collagen, necessary for the normal bone and cartilage functions.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1- Make sure that the area where the patch will be applied is clean and dry, to ensure a perfect adhesion.
- 2- Open the sachet and take one liner. Separate one of the patches from the protective film and stick it on the chosen area of the skin.
- 3- Leave it for 24h. On the next day, remove the patch and apply a new patch in a different area of the body.

WARNINGS

Keep out of reach and sight of children. Do not exceed the advised daily intake. Do not use during pregnancy or breastfeeding. Each patch is for single use only. Keep the product in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.
